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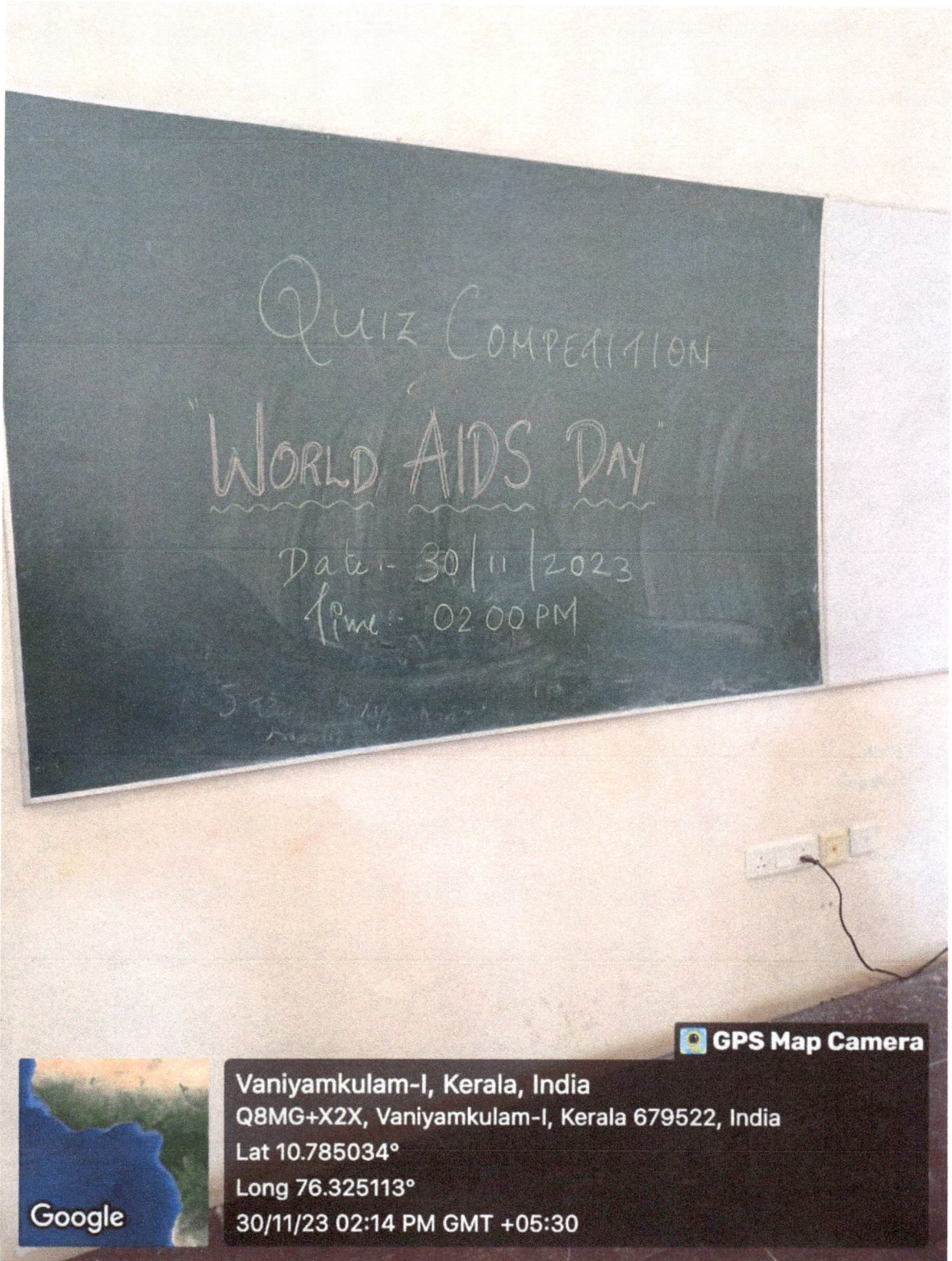
EXHIBITION ON AUDIO VISUAL AIDS

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HERBAL PLANT EXHIBITION

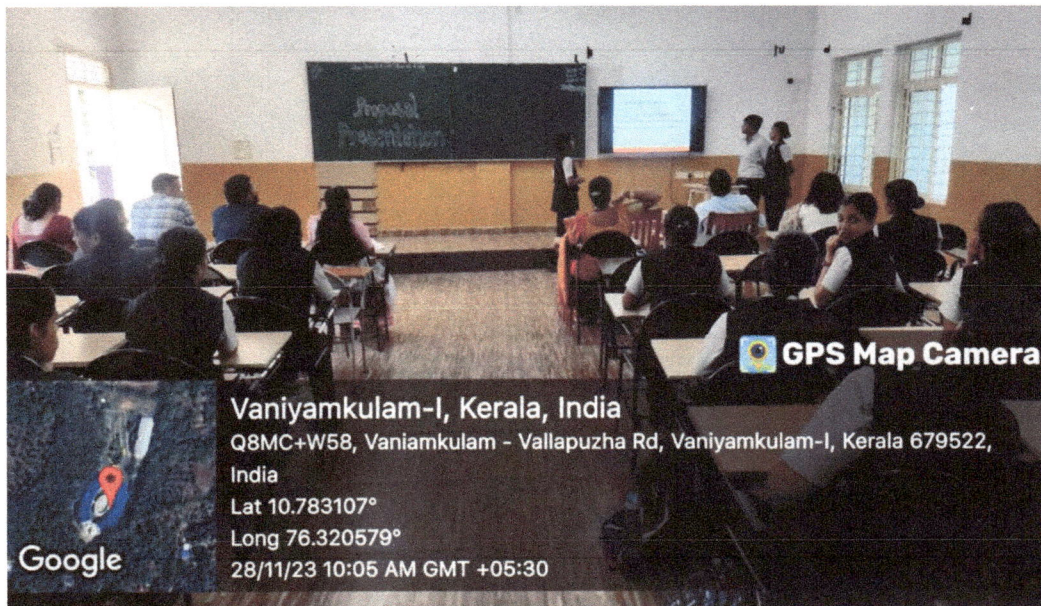

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GROUP PRESENTATION

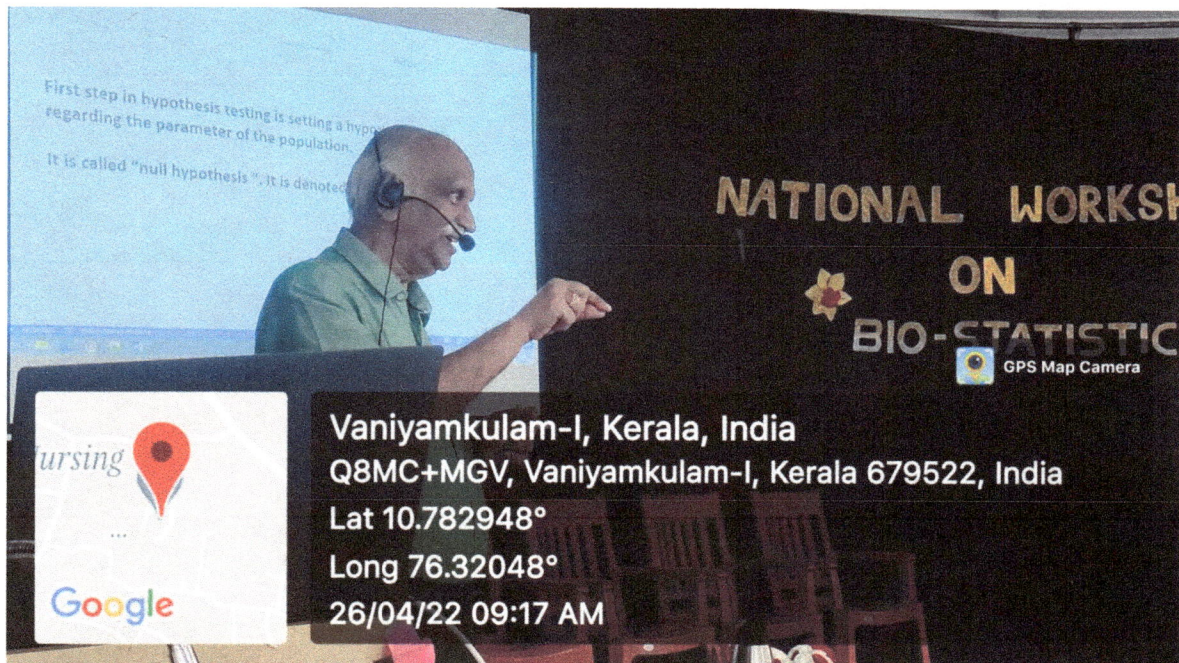

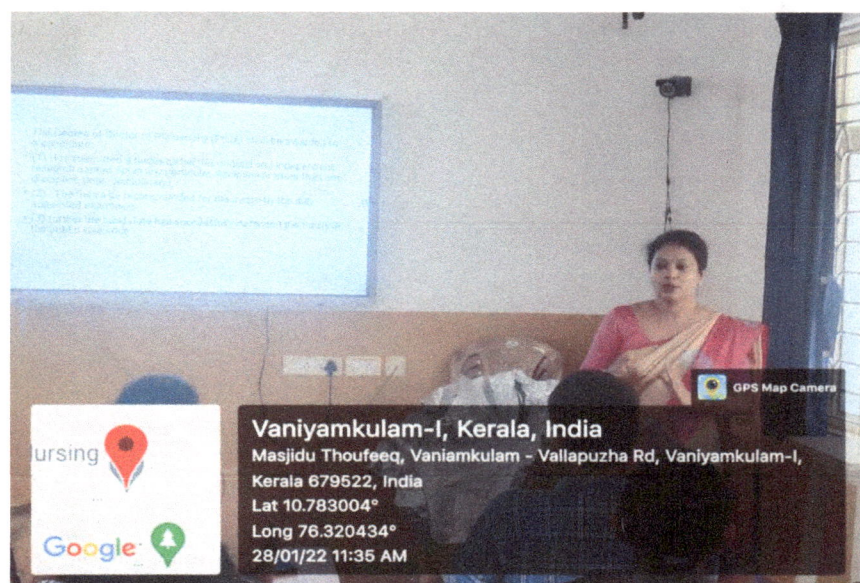


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WORKSHOP ON RESEARCH EXCELLENCE

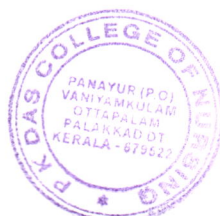
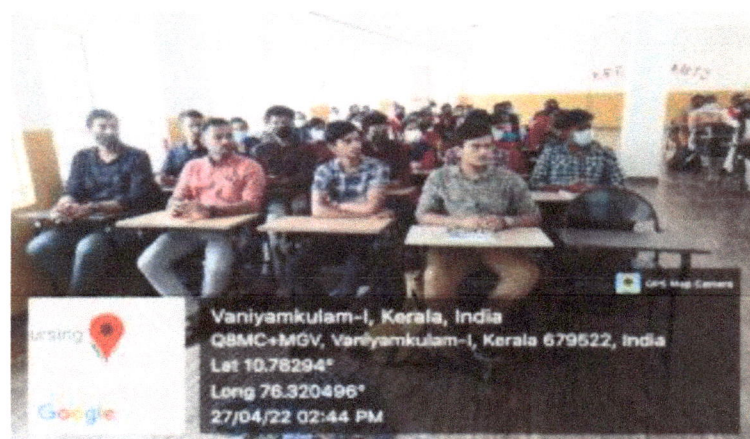


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INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY RIGHTS

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ORGANIC GARDEN

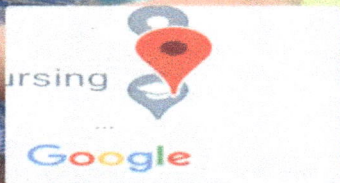
