

As a Part of Journal Club Presentation Mrs. Dina Baby explains regarding critical Review on HIV in Pregnancy. She had critic review on 5 studies regarding the data are collected from Pubmed and google scholar, 2 studies from south Africa and 3 from India, The Knowledge attitude and Practice of mothers about the transmission of HIV from mother to child were assessed. 4 studies the method used are descriptive cross sectional studies and one study conducted as semi structured interview, 4 studies are conducted in antenatal mothers and one in health care volunteers.

The Presentation concluded that the study population showed adequate knowledge about HIV infection, there was a considerable lack of knowledge regarding mother to child transmission of HIV infection and its prevention.
